Disciples are who we are.

Disciplemaking is the essence of the Great Commission (Matthew 28.19-20). **Discipleship** is the process by which God matures us in Christ by His Spirit.

While this happens in a variety of ways, we desire that men and women at Christ Community be intentionally invested in relationships that mature us as disciples of Jesus. To this end, we invite you to participate in one of the two following pathways.

Path 1

Groups of 2-5 men or women gather regularly to help each other mature in Christ. These groups study Scripture and/or helpful Bible-based books, interpret life together according to the Word, pray for one another and often meet every other week.

Path 2: Theological Discipleship

A mature believer disciples 1-3 others, seeking their maturity in Christ using simple, customized material put together by the elders of CCC. This (new) path requires a level of commitment to work through booklets that are based upon the Westminster Shorter Catechism and offer focused discipleship that is: biblical, theological, devotional, missional, and communal. These groups will meet every other week to discuss, apply, and pray about the content that each person has done on their own to prepare for the group meeting.

What then? What should we do?

1 Corinthians 14.26-40

26 What then, brothers? When you come together, each one has a hymn, a lesson, a revelation, a tongue, or an interpretation. Let all things be done for building up. 27 If any speak in a tongue, let there be only two or at most three, and each in turn, and let someone interpret. 28 But if there is no one to interpret, let each of them keep silent in church and speak to himself and to God. 29 Let two or three prophets speak, and let the others weigh what is said. 30 If a revelation is made to another sitting there, let the first be silent. 31 For you can all prophesy one by one, so that all may learn and all be encouraged, 32 and the spirits of prophets are subject to prophets. 33 For God is not a God of confusion but of peace.

As in all the churches of the saints, 34 the women should keep silent in the churches. For they are not permitted to speak, but should be in submission, as the Law also says. 35 If there is anything they desire to learn, let them ask their husbands at home. For it is shameful for a woman to speak in church. 36 Or was it from you that the word of God came? Or are you the only ones it has reached? 37 If anyone thinks that he is a prophet, or spiritual, he should acknowledge that the things I am writing to you are a command of the Lord. 38 If anyone does not recognize this, he is not recognized. 39 So, my brothers, earnestly desire to prophesy, and do not forbid speaking in tongues. 40 But all things should be done decently and in order. ESV

Let all things be done decently and in order, for the building up of the church and for peace.

WITHOUT confusing self-expression. (26-33)

WITH awareness of the Source/authority of the Word. (36-40)

WITH clear expectation. (39-40)
